The project was implemented in coordination with government organizations, particularly Village Development Committees (VDCs), District Development Committee (DDC), District Administration Office (DAO), District Agriculture Development Office (DADO), and community-based institutions such as cooperatives and farmer groups to increase effectiveness of the project interventions.

The main activities were - Impact assessment of earthquake-2015 in target area, distribution of vegetable seeds and technical support, follow-up technical support & end-line survey

Major Achievements

- An assessment of earthquake impact in Kaule, Siddhi, and Shaktikhor VDCs of Chitwan executed focusing on direct impact of the earthquake and its aftershocks on agriculture, livestock, community infrastructures and human-life.
- Supported vegetable seeds to 1, 943 households in three VDCs
- Conducted an end-line survey (155 HHs) with a semi-structured questionnaire

Impact

The project had considerable impact on farm families with improved household income and nutrition; the households consumed different types of vegetable, as well as marketed the surplus vegetables.
